Born 1976, Aarhus, Denmark

Lives and works in Copenhagen, DK

Marie Lund's artistic practice arrives from a contemplation on the interdependencies between architecture, space, objects, and bodies. Her sculptural works hold references to existing, functional objects, which she releases from their original use and transforms through tensile material processes into abstract sculptural structures. Often situated in relation to liminal positions, in resistance to sculpture as autonomous object, they activate their environment, encompassing encounters between body and space, and exchange with artworks by other artists. In turning to ideas of hosting and openness, space is given rather than merely occupied. Accordingly, Lund's sculptures resonate as social as well as spatial frameworks, fostering mutual forms of dependency within exhibition formats.
